Focus Book:

Reading Practice Sessions (RPS) – There are five slots. If there are two adults in your classroom, you can do RPS over 5 days with an independent group each day. If you have three adults, you may be able to fit RPS into three days and use the other two for individual readers.

Individual Readers to be done at least twice each week. This can be done in two of the five RPS sections or you can fit it in when most convenient but this MUST be done.

Handwriting – children who have finished the phonics program, will have one spelling session and one handwriting session each day. For everyone else handwriting must be fit in where convenient.

White Rose mathematics lessons – there will be four sessions each week.

Mastering Number – This is a 10 minute session, four times each week, in addition to the normal White Rose session for KS1. For YR this is a 20 minute session four times each week instead of their White Rose session. White Rose will still be used for SSM. See separate Mastering Number information for details of how each session works.

Literacy Tree - There will be four lessons each week.

PE and Forest School – Class PE and FS sessions will alternate each week. The coach led PE session will happen every week.
