Listen to different kinds of music and talk about how they make you feel. Use voices and instruments to show different sorts of feelings.
	Little Yellow Chicken	Phase 1 Phonics Aspect 6 Animal noises Aspect 4 Learning songs and rhymes Odd one out	Say rhymes and sing songs about chickens, bees, frogs and bugs. Make voice sounds for the different animals. Find the odd one out - words that don't rhyme with bee, frog and bug.
	Animal Boogie	Phase 1 Phonics Aspect 1 Teddy is lost in the jungle Aspect 2 Animal noises Aspect 3 Action songs Aspect 4 Listen to the beat	Chant 'Down in the jungle' using the Animal Boogie version, doing the actions. Make animal sounds from the story. Keep the beat by doing different actions. Monkey is lost in the jungle – hide a monkey and show where it is, by singing loudly.
	The Selfish Crocodile	Phase 1 Phonics Aspect 3 Action songs Aspect 5 Bertha goes to the zoo	Chant 'Row row row your boat'. Say rhymes using 'Never smile at a crocodile' as a

			<p>starting point eg. Never peep at a sheep. Say animal rhymes. Make up a chant using animal names starting with the same letter. Make animal alliterations.</p>
	<p>Lion who wanted to love</p>	<p>Phase One Phonics: Aspect 4 Finish the rhyme/Rhyming bingo Aspect 5 Name play</p>	<p>Finish the rhymes in some phrases from the story. Find rhyming words. Make up alliterations with children's names. Make up alliterations with African animals. Eg. Leo the lion, Ellie the Elephant</p>
