

## Are you ready for learning?

### School readiness (Transition for school)

When your child starts school, it would help them to settle in if they can do some of these things independently. Please work on them at home and let school staff know if they will need help once they come to school.

Put coat on and fasten it up.

Dress and undress themselves.

Put their shoes on the correct feet.

Wash and dry their hands.

Say/sign when they need to use the toilet.

Use the toilet and collect tissue appropriately.

Use a tissue to wipe their nose.

Sit and cross their legs.

Listen when an adult is speaking to them.

Sit on a chair at a table.

Use a drinking cup.

Use a knife and fork to eat their food. Try to cut up their food.

Use their manners e.g. please and thank you.

Share toys and take turns with other children.
