Year One – rising trend prior to Covid..

2020-2021 – no testing due to Covid..

2022 National standard for Year 1 fell by 7%. HNIS standard fell by 10%.

Year 2 retakes National standard fell by just over 4%. HNIS fell by 18%.

Next steps for catch up and recovery.

Phonics took a significant impact during each and every national lockdown. Early acquisition of phonics happens in these early significant years and much ground had to be caught up.

Strategies included introducing daily double phonics sessions for all. Daily individual reading for all pupils with additional reading for vulnerable pupils and planned guided reading sessions in addition. 59% of Year One who had missed significant amounts of time in school, caught up and met the threshold. By the end of Year 2 (2023) this figure is targeted to return to the 85-90% threshold. The target for Year 1 next year is 68%.

All staff have received training on our new Phonics scheme – Little Wandle. This scheme is a systematic synthetic phonics scheme which links directly to the reading scheme to ensure maximum impact. The new scheme was introduced to the pupils in September. Parent's workshops are planned to introduce and share the new scheme. Resource packs have been made ready to go home, as learning will be more rapid with regular home support.
