Hamp Nursery and Infants school standards above national standards

Covid catch up and recovery premium funding, alongside National Tutoring funding was ploughed into targeted interventions on phonics and reading in the first instance for the 2021-2022 year. All PP pupils received additional tutoring, with 11 members of staff trained by the national tutoring program to deliver high quality tutoring. This impacted well on phonics and reading progress. During 2022-2023 double phonics will continue with small tutored groups and interventions as identified.
