Homework Policy

Activities are provided to support and reinforce work which your child will have undertaken at school.

Government guidelines state that children in Years 1 and 2 should spend a minimum of one hour per week on homework activities.

We recommend ten minutes individual reading daily. This can be the sharing of school reading books and books from home.

As your child progresses through school this will be supplemented by other appropriate tasks such as literacy and numeracy activities and games.

It is a requirement of the school that books and all school resources are returned daily.

The School's Agreement:

As a school, we promise to:

- ◆ Treat your child with fairness and care, making sure they feel happy and safe at school.
- ◆ Provide high-quality teaching, helping your child do their best in every area of school life and enjoy learning.
- ◆ Support your child's personal growth, encouraging them to be responsible and respectful towards others.
- ◆ Set appropriate homework, to reinforce their learning at home.
- ◆ Keep you informed about your child's progress, through regular meetings and updates on school activities.
- ◆ Be welcoming and inclusive and offer chances for you to get involved in school life.
- ◆ Operate a clearly stated relational policy so expectations are consistent and supportive.
- ◆ Listen and respond to your concerns and answer your questions as quickly as possible.
