It is not too late to sign your child up for a flu immunisation. The immunisation is a harmless nasal spray and takes just a second to complete. The Nursing team are very kind and supportive to the children, their teacher or TA will be with them at all times and the children often find it easier to sit with their peers for the immunisations, being reassured by watching each other and seeing it is nothing to worry about. Flu is a nasty illness that can lead to more serious complications such as pneumonia and bronchitis. You would need to complete the consent form online – the link to the form is as follows:

### **School Data Collection and Consent Forms**


