Online Safety Workshops – Thursday 20th November

We know that many of you are worried about the safety risks of the digital world. Risks to children online include:

- **Inappropriate content:** Children may be exposed to violent, sexual, or other harmful material that they are not emotionally ready for. This includes seeing hate speech, propaganda, or content that promotes self-harm.
- **Cyberbullying:** Young people can be targets of online harassment, threats, or abusive behaviour, which can have severe consequences, including an increased risk of self-harm or suicide.
- **Online predators:** Malicious individuals may pose as children to groom, exploit, or sexually abuse them, making it vital to protect children from contact with strangers online.
- **Privacy and oversharing:** Children may unknowingly share personal information, which can be used for marketing or other purposes and can have consequences later in life.


