Dear Parents/Carers,

Parents' Day – Friday 4th July*

Please see your child's class teacher on Monday to book a time-slot for Parents' Day. We will share and discuss your child's report with you and update you on their progress this year; discuss their next steps and answer any questions or address any concerns you may have. School will be closed on this day, but please bring your child with you for their appointment, so that they can show you their work and books after you have met with their class teacher.

*Please note, due to circumstances beyond our control, Stardust class will have their appointments on a separate day. Mrs. Beresford will meet with parents whilst their children are in school on either Monday 30th June or Tuesday 1st July. Stardust class children do not need to attend school on Friday 4th July.

Parking

The residents of Elmside house have been in touch again, as have their housing association. They are not happy at the disruption that a few of our parents and children are causing by using their car park. The car park for the flats is private and not open to non-residents. They have been advised to photograph your car registrations and report these to the traffic officers. I am aware that fines have been issued through the post based on photographic evidence, so urge the few families that regularly park there to seek a sensible alternative, whilst also avoiding parking or pulling up to drop off on the zig-zag lines, as this endangers all of the children and adults in the area.

Year Two Leavers' Assembly

A few parents have asked whether they will be able to bring younger children to the Year Two Leavers' assembly on 16th July. "Moving On" is such a big step for the children (they are still very little children themselves) and they love to see you there supporting them. However as younger children, babies and toddlers can be quite noisy and disruptive, which is very off-putting for the children trying to speak or present something to their audience, we do suggest that you try to find alternative child care for your younger children if you can. This also means your attention is not divided and you can focus on your school leaver. If you are unable to do so then you may bring them in but we will ask that you sit at the back by the door so you can pop outside with them if they are becoming a disruption.
