Paddington Bear – Crocodiles - Green
Night Pirates - Zebras – Black and white

As mentioned above we are inviting parents in throughout the day to help with reading, crafting and book related activities. We will send out paper slips a bit nearer the time so you can "book in". Hopefully this will mean less waiting to sign in at Reception when you arrive.
