Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for supporting **Children in Need** today. We will let you know how much you raised next week.

The **Scholastic book fair** was very successful. Thanks to all the money you spent, our commission comes to almost £300.00, which we will spend on (you won't be surprised!) lovely new books for our little Library.

You should hopefully have received a letter yesterday regarding our **Christmas Play**. If you have any questions, or if you did not receive our letter, please speak to your child's class teacher. This includes your booking form for your two tickets. As I said in the letter, we do have to be strict about the two tickets per family in the first instance. We do expect that some extra spaces will become available, but as we will keep booking open until Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December, we will not know how many spaces are available until after then. If you would like an extra ticket, please come into the school office or phone the school office from the morning of Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December. We are not keeping a list of early requests so please do not put your additional request on your original two tickets slip as this will not secure you an extra ticket. They will be given on a first come first served basis AFTER the general booking closes. We can guarantee enough space to accommodate all requests for the first two tickets, and hopefully give everyone their first choice of date and time. Your tickets will be issued to your child during the last week of November. If you do not receive your requested tickets by the 29<sup>th</sup> November, please let us know quickly, so we don't give the places away. From Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> December, I'm afraid I cannot guarantee any spaces for those who forgot to book.

Some of you may be aware of an incident that happened outside our school gates at 6.30pm yesterday evening.
