CHRISTMAS PLAY

This year we will be holding four main performances of our Christmas Play 'Boogie Woogie Nativity'. Two performances will take place each day on **9th** and **10th December** at **9.30am** and **10.30am**, in the school hall. For these performances, we will not be able to accommodate babies, toddlers or preschool children in the audience.

As in previous years, there will be a separate performance for parents who wish to bring their nursery and younger children to watch the Christmas Play, and this is being held on **11th December** at **10.30am** in Holy Trinity Church. As advised above, this is the only performance that babies, toddlers and preschool children may attend, although nursery children attending their setting on the morning of 5th December will be brought into school to watch the dress rehearsal.

Photographs/Recordings

In the interests of safeguarding, and following complaints from several parents in previous years, we must please ask that no photographs/recordings are taken of the children before, during or after the performances. Please also ensure that all mobile phones are switched off at all times whilst you are in school and for the performance in church. Thank you for your understanding.

The class teachers will be taking individual photographs to send home with each child, and a recording of the Play will be uploaded to Google Classroom on Friday 13th December.

Under the terms of the Data Protection Act, we are obliged to ask if you have any objection to your child being filmed and to the recording being available to other families. If for any reason you do not wish your child to appear in the recording of the Christmas Play, please contact me immediately.

Tickets

Tickets will be available on a first come, first served basis. Due to limited space in the hall, we have had to set the number of tickets at 90 for each performance, and a maximum of **two** tickets per family will be allocated, irrespective of the number of children you have at the school. These could be used together for one performance or separately, i.e. one ticket each for two separate performances.

There may be spare tickets available after the initial allocation; please contact the school office on Wednesday 4th December to check what we have left.

To avoid oversights, please return your completed ticket request slip directly to the school office rather than returning it in your child's bookbag. Thank you.

★ Please ensure you arrive promptly for the performance you are attending as we regret that latecomers will not be admitted. Our children are young and we are sure you will appreciate that they would be very distracted by parents/carers arriving part way through the performance. If you arrive late, we will do our best to offer you tickets for another time/day, if we have any available.
